

HOW TO DETERMINE YOUR RING SIZE.

Ring measurements are very precise. Carefully follow these instructions to obtain an accurate measurement.

- Prior to printing, ensure that Page Scaling is set to "None" on your print dialog box. (To open the print dialog box, press CTRL+P.)
- Measure the bar below. It must be exactly 1 inch or 30 mm long. Alternately, place a quarter where indicated. The quarter should fit completely over the image so that all lines are covered, without the quarter hanging over any edges.



MEASURE YOUR FINGER.

- 1. Print it make sure to uncheck the "Fit To Page" option in your print dialog box.
- 2. Cut out the sizer.
- 3. Make a slot in the sizer by cutting along the dotted line.
- 4. Roll the sizer into a circle with the numbers on the outside.
- 5. Insert the end of the tab into the slot.
- 6. Place the sizer around your finger and pull the tab through the slot until the paper is snug around your finger.
- 7. Read your finger size on the scale.
