## HOW TO DETERMINE YOUR RING SIZE.

## Ring measurements are very precise. Carefully follow these instructions to obtain an accurate measurement.

1. Prior to printing, ensure that Page Scaling is set to "None" on your print dialog box.
(To open the print dialog box, press CTRL+P.)
2. Measure the bar below. It must be exactly 1 inch or 30 mm long. Alternately, place a quarter where indicated. The quarter should fit completely over the image so that all lines are covered, without the quarter hanging over any edges.

## MEASURE YOUR FINGER.

1. Print it - make sure to uncheck the "Fit To Page" option in your print dialog box.
2. Cut out the sizer.
3. Make a slot in the sizer by cutting along the dotted line.
4. Roll the sizer into a circle with the numbers on the outside.
5. Insert the end of the tab into the slot.
6. Place the sizer around your finger and pull the tab through the slot until the paper is snug around your finger.
7. Read your finger size on the scale.
